

Kaskia cf. chesterensis (Weller & Weller in J.M. Weller, 1936) (TH541a)

Kaskia → Proetida → Proetina → Proetidea → Proetidae

Provenance : US; Northern Alabama, Franklin County, shore of Cedar Creek Lake

Formation : Bangor Limestone Fm

Age : Carboniferous, Mississippian

Details : Partial pygidium only, on a litter on sea bottom hash including a nice gasteropod which I would later give an additional prep (see very last images). A present from my good friend Sébastien Pierard, whom gave it to me after I'd prepped it myself (along with several other specimen). Second detail image of pygidium was made after slightly moistening the stone (by breathing on it).
