

***Ogygiocarella angustissima* (Salter, 1865) (TH563)**

Ogygiocarella → Asaphida → Asaphina → Asaphoidea → Asaphidae → Ogygiocaridinae

Provenance : UK; England, Shropshire, Betton Quarry

Formation : ? Fm

Age : Ordovician

Details : Near-complete specimen, missing librigenae, as part-counterpart moulds. From old collection. The label mentioned "Salop", which is the historical name of Shropshire (so I already corrected that in the caption above) as county in which the specimen was found. First detail images are of the internal mould, the latter 2 of the external one. Additional info : compared to *O. debuchii* (Brongniart, 1822) *O. angustissima* is a relatively rare species in the Middle Ordovician strata of Wales and Shropshire.
