

***Cornuproetus midas amlanensis*** (G.K.B. Alberti, 1969) (TH444)

***Cornuproetus*** → Proetida → Proetina → Proetoidea → Proetidae → Cornuproetinae

**Provenance** : Morocco, M'cissi

**Formation** : ? Fm

**Age** : Middle Devonian (Eifelian)

**Details** : Complete specimen, albeit with slightly disarticulated librigenae (thus inferring that we're dealing with a moult here), and also with a little chip of exoskeleton missing (must've splintered away during extraction). My good friend Haddach purchased this as brut (prep) material with the tag "*Cornoproetus*, pas commun" (see next page for the piece(s) as bought, and thus before prep),

I had gathered a nice group of friends to join me on my Moroccan trilobite hunt of 2020, but mere days before our proposed departure our flights were cancelled. In hindsight, that was a good thing, as my friend Haddach (whom had traveled to Morocco a week before) got stuck in his native country for just over 3 months (that could've happened to us as well, see?).
