

***Cornuproetus midas amianensis* (G.K.B. Alberti, 1969) (TH444)**

Cornuproetus → Proetida → Proetina → Proetoidea → Proetidae → Cornuproetinae

Provenance : Morocco, M'cissi

Formation : ? Fm

Age : Middle Devonian (Eifelian)

Details : Complete specimen, albeit with slightly disarticulated librigenae (thus inferring that we're dealing with a moult here), and also with a little chip of exoskeleton missing (must've splintered away during extraction). My good friend Haddach purchased this as brut (prep) material with the tag "Cornoproetus, pas commun" (see next page for the piece(s) as bought, and thus before prep),

I had gathered a nice group of friends to join me on my Moroccan trilobite hunt of 2020, but mere days before our proposed departure our flights were cancelled.
