

## Cornuproetinae **gen. & sp. indet.** (TH31)

**Details** : Bought as “Cornuproetus sp.”...Stone looks like it might come from “Couche Rouge”. Trilobite looks very similar to **Diademaproetus praecursor**. According to Herve Toublanc, this specimen would be “**Pontoproetus granulatus**” from the (Emsian-aged) Tazoulait Fm on the Djebel Mrakib. Problem : Molinaro (2012) erected the genus as part of a master thesis dissertation, but it remains a nomen nudum.
