ADDITIONAL INFO ON PHACOPIDINA MICHELI

The species has 2 subspecies: *P. m. micheli* (Tromelin, 1877, original description as *Dalmanites micheli*), and *P. m. couyerensis* Henry 1980. Funky detail: the placement in *Phacopidina* was done by Henry et al., in 1976. The latter is probably far less common than the first...or it would not have taken over a century before someone noticed the difference. Regretfully, I have no idea what that difference may be (hope to find out one day though!).
