Sokhretia solitaria (Barrande, 1846, as *Dalmanites*) (TH658)

Sokhretia → Phacopida → Phacopina → Acastoidea → Acastidae

Details: Some time ago the city of Prague decided to dig a tunnel (or rather two tunnels) to enlarge its underground tram/train network...not certain any more what it was...but one of the tracks started (or ended) at Pancrac. So...I guess this specimen (and TH658, **Onnia Superba**) is part of a lot that was "saved" from being crushed and grinded (for possible road-works, you know).

Some history background: a year after Barrande's publication, Hawle & Corda described the species as *Phacops ovoideus...* which obviously became a "nomen nudum". Hupé (1956) would eventually place the species in his newly erected *Sokhretia* genus, but in the meantime it was also known as *Phacopidina* and its subgenus *Kloucekia* (or was it the other way around?).
