Below an image of the original brut material, with a beginning of the *Stuveaspis*' prep. As visible in the images above we're dealing with a moult here: cephalon slightly disarticulated from the rest of the body, and several thorax segments are "out of line" as well.

The genus is rather wide-spread in Morocco. While most species of the genus can apparently be found in the vicinity of Jorf, *Struveaspis bignoni* Corbacho, 2013 was originally described from Jbel Amlane; *S. maroccanica* (Alberti, 1970) is also found at Jbel Amlane and Gara Mdouard; *S. micomma* (Roemer, 1852) was described from Dechra-ait-Abdallah (Meseta Est Casablanca) and reported also Jbel Gara el Zguilma; and *S. "struvei*" (so far only reported from Jorf). *S. prantli* (Ruzicka, 1996) is a species known only from the Jbel Amlane area. Specimens of *Struveaspis* have also been found on the Djebel Mrakib (Maharch and Tafroute).
